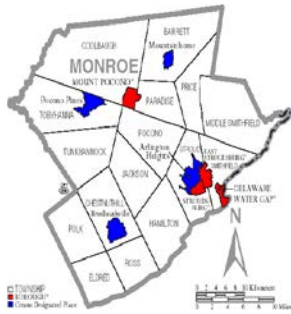

Special Programs and Initiatives

- I-80 Tannersville Interchange Earmark - NEPA and District 5-0 are attempting to incorporate the use of a of a \$15 million earmark for highway and HOP improvements and prospective land developments toward needed safety and congestion improvements around Interstate 80 Interchanges 298 and 299.
- Safe80 Task Force - The NEPA RPO approved a TIP Amendment on June 21, 2011 to add \$57,600 in funding for administration of the Safe80 Taskforce. NEPA staff is currently working to secure the balance of matching funds for this project.
- New Freedom Program – An application was submitted by the Monroe County Transit Authority (MCTA) for Interactive Voice Response Telephone System Add On was approved for \$12,000.
- In Monroe County, the Downtown East Stroudsburg- the Pedestrian Experience Phase II was approved for \$348,922 for the 2011-2012 round of the Transportation Enhancement Program.
