### Special Programs & Initiatives

- NEPA staff solicited applications for the 2011-2012 round of the Transportation Enhancement Program, which included \$700,000 in available funds for projects within the NEPA RPO region (Carbon, Monroe, Pike, Schuylkill and Wayne counties). The NEPA (RPO) received eight (8) Transportation Enhancement (TE) program applications. The projects were from various municipalities located within the five-county RPO region. The eight (8) applications requested a cumulative total of \$1.85 million in program funds. Three (3) projects were recommended for funding by the RPO Committee. In Pike County, the Revitalization of Pennsylvania Avenue Project in Matamoras Borough was recommended for \$287,500.
- Greene Township - NEPA wrote and submitted a Local Share Account (Gaming Funds) grant application for \$2,075,000 to construct a new municipal building on behalf of the Township
- Milford Borough, Pike County – The Route 6 Heritage Corporation recently named the Borough of Milford as a Heritage Community. NEPA staff coordinated and assisted in the facilitation of the final Community Workshop which was held Monday, March 21, 2011 at the First Presbyterian Church. Final Community Work Plan recommendations were presented.
- Provided Technical Assistance for the Matamoras Borough, Lackawaxen and Shohola Townships Pa Conservation works ARRA grant. This included grant proposal and assistance as well as model contract documents.
