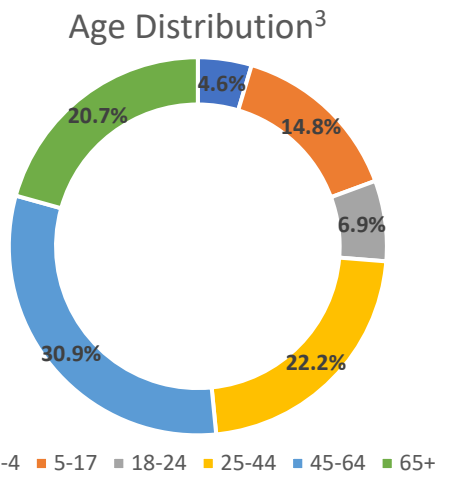
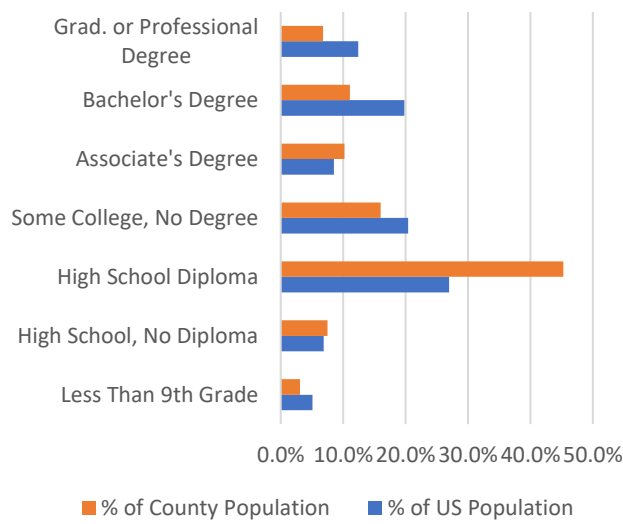

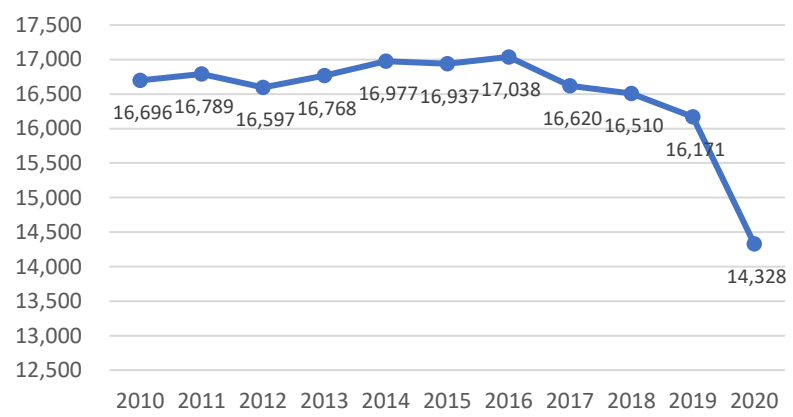


Education Attainment²
